1 BY MS. LIZARRAGA:

2 Q. Good morning, Special Agent. Could you please
3 state and spell your last name for the record?

4 A. Jennifer Sullivan, S-U-L-L-I-V-A-N.

5 Q. And where are you currently employed?

6 A. I'm an FBI agent.

7 Q. And what is your role there?

8 A. I'm a full-time polygraph examiner.

9 Q. Let's go through a little bit of your
10 background. Can you please tell me about your prior law
11 enforcement experience?

12 A. I became a sworn police officer in Chandler,
13 Arizona, in 1982. Then promoted to detective, where I
14 worked violent crimes and crimes against children until
15 1989. I was hired by the FBI, and I've been employed
16 with the FBI up until today, almost 25 years. And the
17 entire time working criminal offenses, mostly violent
18 crime. And now I do polygraph.

19 Q. And how long have you been doing polygraph
20 examinations?

21 A. Since 2005.

22 Q. What kind of training and certifications do you
23 have to receive in order to become a polygraph examiner?

24 A. The polygraph certification is a four-month
25 school at the Department of Defense in Columbia, South

1 Carolina, full-time for four full months. Rigorous
2 training. And once they teach you how to do the
3 mechanics of the polygraph, there's training for
4 interview and interrogation and so forth.

5 Q. And are there any sort of certifications that
6 you hold?

7 A. I'm a federally certified polygraph examiner
8 through the Department of Defense.

9 Q. Are there any continuing education courses that
10 you attend?

11 A. Every two years, we're required to receive or
12 obtain 40 hours. I take a lot more training than that,
13 but 40 hours minimum every two years.

14 Q. And are you up to date on your --

15 A. I am current, yes.

16 Q. Okay. Special Agent Sullivan, are you familiar
17 with the defendant, James Jeremiah Dyson?

18 A. I am.

19 Q. And do you see him in the courtroom today?

20 A. I do.

21 Q. Could you please point out an article of
22 clothing that he's wearing, and state where he's sitting?

23 A. He's sitting next to the defense attorney, and
24 he is wearing a blue button-down shirt with a tie.
