

## Case Synopsis/Interview Results

Reference is made to the authorization given by the SAIC - Forensic Services Division to administer this examination dated 09-21-98.

The examinee is an applicant for employment within the United States Secret Service. In accordance with Secret Service employment regulations, the examinee was administered a standard pre-employment screening exam.

Prior to the examination, Special Agent Applicant William V. Roche application forms were reviewed, and no derogatory information was listed.

During the Series I pre-test interview, the examinee made no derogatory admissions.

During the Series I in-test, the charts were evaluated to display No Significant Physiological Responses to the relevant questions.

During the Series II in-test, the charts were evaluated to be inconclusive to the relevant question concerning illegal drug use. The remaining relevant questions were evaluated to display No Significant Physiological Responses.

During the Series II post-test interview, the examinee made no derogatory admissions.

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During the Series III pre-test interview, the examinee made no derogatory admissions.

During the Series III in-test, the charts were evaluated to be Inconclusive to the relevant questions.



## Case Synopsis/Interview Results

Reference is made to the authorization given by the SAIC - Forensic Services Division to administer this examination dated 09-18-98.

The examinee is an applicant for employment within the United States Secret Service. In accordance with Secret Service employment regulations, the examinee was administered a standard pre-employment screening exam.

Reference is made to the previous polygraph examination of Special Agent applicant William V. Roche, dated 10/13/98, during which applicant Roche was evaluated Inconclusive to the issue regarding illegal drugs.

This examination was conducted as re-test of Series II issues only.

Prior to the examination, Special Agent applicant William V. Roche's application forms were reviewed and it was noted that he disclosed no derogatory information.

During the Series I pre-test interview, Roche made no pre-test admissions.

Series I was then administered and the examinee displayed No Significant Physiological Responses to the question regarding falsification of forms. The questions regarding serious crime and illegal drug use were evaluated inconclusive.

During Series I post-test interview, Roche made no post-test admissions.
