TAPE members who use this service at least once a year by sending in ten dollars and a stamped self return envelope containing at least one of their complete polygraph examinations consisting of advisements, waivers, interview forms, final polygraph examination report, complete polygraph examination question list, all test charts, calibration chart and all other attendant printed documents and electronic information. The entire package will be reviewed and a complete confidential review of the package will be provided. The complete original package will be returned, no copies will be retained and no identifying information will kept. The review will include suggestions for use in future exams/interviews; and, suggestions of what could be changed or up dated. If you use this

service you can include in your polygraph reports that you “use a “Quality Control Review Process sponsored and approved by TAPE.” The use of this service will enhance your polygraph service, your testing methods, question formulation and report writing. Limestone Rep Sue Luttrell said her company can enter your reporting forms into their program format after you buy a Limestone system. Their program can also collect statistical information so that all you need to do is push a button and your data is collected for research information, push another button and your report is printed out.

Sue indicated that their programmers will collect all of the reporting formats and select and compile the best information from all of the formats and put that information into “The Best of Reports,” this will be a report format compiled from all reports to make “The Best Report.” Then if you desire to change your report format, the best report format is available to you.
